COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1736, L.D. 1854, Bill,  
"AN ACT Pertaining to the Time for Recording a Tax Lien  
Mortgage."

Amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out in the 3rd  
line from the end(same in L.D.) the underlined figure "20"  
and inserting in its place the underlined figure '30'

Further amend the Bill in section 2 by striking out in the  
3rd line (same in L.D.) the underlined figure "20" and inserting  
in its place the underlined figure '30'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to increase the time period  
a taxpayer has to respond to a notice of a tax lien from 20  
days in the original bill to 30 days.
