COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1749, L.D. 1865, Bill,
"AN ACT to Clarify the Law Concerning Income Taxation of Servicemen
who are Maine Residents."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting
clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §5102, sub-~~§~~5, as enacted by P&SL 1969,
c. 154, §F, is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to
read:

For purposes of this subsection, a Maine-domiciled individual
who is absent from Maine because of his compliance with orders
of the Armed Forces of the United States may not be deemed to
maintain a permanent place of abode in any state, territory or
possession of the United States, other than Maine, or in the
District of Columbia.

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this Act shall
become effective with regard to tax years beginning
January 1, 1980.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment narrows the original bill to apply only to
those servicemen who are benefitting from the protection of the
Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act. It also provides that
the bill shall be effective for tax years beginning
January 1, 1980.
