HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1762,
L.D. 1888, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Effective Date of
Administrative Change in the Employment Security Law."

Amend the Amendment by inserting after section 30 the
following:

'Sec. 30-A. 26 MRSA §1221, sub-§14, ¶D is enacted to
read:

D. For purposes of this subsection, a governmental
entity is not liable for contributions or payments
in lieu of contributions because of benefits paid
to a part-time police officer or part-time firefighter
employed by the governmental entity.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exempt, from liability
for contributions into the Employment Security Fund, a
governmental unit which hires a part-time police officer or
firefighter in those situations where the officer is laid off
from another job.
