SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 734, L.D. 1913, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize a Bond Issue in the Amount of \$4,500,000 for Energy Conservation Improvements for Public School Buildings and the University of Maine."

Amend the Amendment by inserting after the Title the following:

'Amend the Bill by striking out in the Title the figure "\$4,500,000" and inserting in its place the figure '\$7,000,000'

Further amend the Amendment by striking out in the first line after the Title the word "Amend" and inserting in its place the words 'Further amend'

Further amend the Amendment, on page 2, by striking out in the 6th line from the end the words and figure "Cost: \$2.5 million" and inserting in their place the following 'Cost: \$5 million'

Further amend the Amendment by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Further amend the Bill in section 10 by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

"Shall a bond issue be ratified in the amount of \$7,000,000 for energy conservation improvements for public school buildings and the University of Maine?"'

Statement of Fact

This amendment raises the amount of the bond issue to \$7,000,000 for energy conservation improvements in Maine's public schools and the University of Maine. This amendment makes \$5,000,000 of the \$7,000,000 available for public school energy conservation improvements. This is two times as much as proposed in the original bill. The university's portion will remain as originally proposed, at \$2,000,000.
