COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1797, L.D. 1919, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Games of Chance at Agricultural Fairs."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the
amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'2-A. Games of chance at agricultural fairs. The Chief
of the State Police may not refuse to issue any license to
hold, conduct or operate any game of chance at any agricultural
fair, if the game of chance is the same as one previously
licensed by the Chief of the State Police, as long as the
issuance of the license is not in violation of law.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the intent
of the sponsor to insure that no game of chance previously
licensed by the Chief of the State Police for agricultural
fairs will be denied a license in the future.
