COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1830, L.D. 1934, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Adjust License Fees, for Inflation, for the Department  
of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and  
inserting in its place the following: 'AN ACT to Require the  
Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to Recommend  
License Fee Schedules to the Legislature.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of the amending  
clause and inserting in its place the following:

'12 MRSA §7034, sub-§9 is enacted to read:'

Further amend the Bill in the first line after the amending  
clause (same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure  
"8." and inserting in its place the underlined figure '9.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment changes the title to make it clear that  
the bill will not raise fish and wildlife license fees. The  
bill only directs the commissioner to recommend to the Legislatur  
a proposed fee schedule. The amendment also changes the  
subsection number to avoid a conflict with L.D. 1933.
