COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1832, L.D. 1936, Bill, "AN ACT to Create a Combination Nonresident Hunting and Fishing License."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7101, sub-§5, ¶H, as amended by PL 1979, c. 543, §7, is further amended to read:

H. Alien big game hunting license.....~~§105.00~~ \$105.50
(Permits hunting of all species, including deer and bear)

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7101, sub-§5, ¶¶'s I, J and K are enacted to read:

I. Nonresident combination hunting and fishing license...\$87.50

J. Alien small game hunting license.....\$50.50
(Permits hunting of all species, except deer and bear)

K. Alien combination hunting and fishing license..\$140.50

Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §7102, sub-§3, ¶D is enacted to read:

D. Alien archery license.....\$50.50

Sec. 4. 12 MRSA §7151, sub-§5, ¶I is enacted to read:

I. Alien season fishing.....\$50.50
(16 years of age or older)'

Statement of Fact

This amendment increases the fee for a nonresident combination hunting and fishing license from \$85.50 in the original bill to \$87.50.

The amendment also creates new license categories for alien small game, archery, fishing and combination licenses. The existing alien big game license is increased from \$105.00 to \$105.50. The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife estimates that this amendment will increase dedicated revenues by approximately \$2,000.
