HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1879,
L.D. 1962, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Inland Fisheries and
Wildlife Laws of Maine."

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the first
paragraph after the title and inserting in its place the
following:

'Amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated
"§7055." in the 3rd line (same in L.D.) by striking out the
underlined words "coastal wardens" and inserting in their place
the underlined words 'marine patrol officers' and in the last
2 lines (same in L.D.) by striking out the punctuation and
words ", and shall receive for similar services the same fees
as those of game wardens" and inserting in their place the
following: '~~and shall receive for similar services the same
fees as those of game wardens~~'

Further amend the Amendment by inserting before the last
paragraph before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Further amend the Bill in section 31 in that part designated
"§7616." in the last line (same in L.D.) by striking out the
words "or Canada" and inserting in their place the following:
'er, Canada or Alaska or their adjacent waters'

This amendment corrects a reference to marine patrol officers

and clarifies a section on the selling of salmon.
