HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1879, L.D. 1962, Bill,
"AN ACT to Clarify the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Laws
of Maine."

Amend the bill in section 33 by striking out all of
the last paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'A person, including any agent of the State, is guilty
of use or possession of a gill net if he uses or ~~possess~~
possesses a gill net.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment will make it clear that the prohibition
on the use of gill nets applies to all persons, including
agents of the State.
