HOUSE AMENDMENT" A" to S.P. 766, L.D. 1963, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Funds for Residential Energy Conservation."

Amend the bill in section 7, subsection 2, in the 2nd line (same in L.D.) by striking out the words "constituting a" and inserting in their place the following:

'constituting a an owner-occupied'

Further amend the bill in section 8 in the 5th line (same in L.D.) by inserting after the word "constituting" the underlined words 'owner-occupied'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 12 the following:

'Sec. 13. Repeal; review. This Act is repealed on December 31, 1983 and the provisions of the Maine Revised Statutes affected by this Act shall be amended to read as if this Act had not been enacted.

The Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs shall report on the provisions of this Act to the Second regular session of the 111th Legislature in accordance with the provisions of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 1, sections 2502 and 2503.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment requires that 1 to 4 family housing units, affected by the bill, be owner-occupied. It also repeals the Act on December 31, 1983.
