HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to S.P. 770, L.D. 1964, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Make Corrections of Errors and Inconsistencies in  
the Laws of Maine."

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency  
clause the following:

' Sec. 251. Resolves 1979, c. 32, next to the last paragraph  
is amended to read:

Transfer of certain state property authorized. Resolved:  
That, in honor and recognition of our former Governor James B.  
Longley, the desk and chair used by him ~~while-chairman~~ during  
sessions of the Executive Council, which is now the property  
of the State Law Library, be presented to him as a gift on behalf  
of the State.'

to former Governor Longley as chairman of the Executive Council.
