HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to S.P. 770, L.D. 1964, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Make Corrections of Errors and Inconsistencies in the  
Laws of Maine."

Amend the Bill by inserting after section 65 the following:

'Sec. 66. 12 MRSA §6439, first ¶, as enacted by PL 1977,  
c. 661, §5, is amended to read:

It shall be unlawful to have on any trawl more than 3  
lobster traps ~~en-one-warp-and-buoy~~ in any of the coastal waters  
in the following areas:'

Further amend the Bill by renumbering the sections to  
read consecutively.

Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes from the Marine Resources laws  
the requirement that the restriction of 3 lobster traps to a  
trawl also be limited to one warp and buoy. This amendment  
embodies the present enforcement policy of the Department of  
Marine Resources.
