SENATE AMENDMENT " B" to H.P. 1891, L.D. 1966, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide Broad Public Representation on the Board of
Pesticides Control and to Improve the Level of Information
Available to it and the Public."

Amend the Bill in section 3, in that part designated
"§1471-B." by inserting after subsection 5 the following:

'6. Registration of pesticides. No determination of the
commissioner pursuant to Title 7, chapter 103, subchapter II-A,
with respect to the refusal to register or renew registration,
cancellation, suspension or limitation of use of any pesticide
is effective until approved by the board. The board shall not
approve any such refusal, cancellation, suspension or limitation
for any pesticide registered by the United States Environmental
Protection Agency under the United States Insecticide, Fungicide
and Rodenticide Act, Public Law 92-516, unless a public hearing
has been held.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment consolidates in the board the final authority
to limit pesticide usage.
