SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1895, L.D. 1971, RESOLVE,
Authorizing the Exchange of Certain Public Reserved Lands,
Georgia-Pacific Corporation.

Amend the Resolve in EXHIBIT "B" by striking out
all of the line:

"18ED BPP Washington 1,000"

Further amend the Resolve in EXHIBIT "B" by striking
out all of the "TOTAL" line and inserting in its place the
following:

'TOTAL9,496'

Further amend the Resolve in EXHIBIT "B" by striking
out all of the last map before the statement of fact
dealing with "18 ED BPP, 1,000 acres"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove from the
resolve a tract of land in Township 18 in Washington County.
This 1,000 acre tract is one of the choice pieces of acreage
in the State and is part of a consolidated public lot. As

such, this tract should be retained by the State for the benefit of the people of the State and should not be conveyed pursuant to the resolve.
