the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:


'Sec. 2. 10 MRSA §803, sub-§2, ¶A, as amended by PL 1979,

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to strike out that portion
of the bill which changes the limit applicable to the guaranteed
Recreational
portion of an individual/project from \$2,500,000 to \$7,000,000.
