COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1917, L.D. 1982, Bill,
"AN ACT to Authorize Deductions from the Term of Imprisonment
of Certain Persons Serving a Split Sentence."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and before the emergency clause and in-
serting in its place the following:

'17-A MRSA §1203, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

4. Each person sentenced to an initial unsuspended
term of imprisonment in excess of 120 days under this
section for a crime committed on or after July 6, 1978,
and on or before September 13, 1979, shall earn deductions
authorized by section 1253, subsections 3, 3-A, 3-B and 4.'
