COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1916, L.D. 1985, Bill,
"AN ACT to Authorize Bond Issues in the Amount of \$4,000,000
in each of 3 years for Court Facilities Improvements."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and in-
serting in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Authorize a Bond Issue in the Amount of
\$4,000,000 for Court Facilities Improvements.'

Further amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out all
of the first sentence and inserting in its place the following:

'The Treasurer of State is authorized , under the direction of
the Governor, to issue from time to time serial coupon bonds
in the name and behalf of the State to an amount not exceeding
\$4,000,000 to be issued after July 1, 1981; for the purpose of
raising funds to provide for such capital improvements, con-
struction, renovations, equipment and furnishings as authorized
by section 6.'

Further amend the Bill in section 3 by striking out all
of the last sentence and inserting in its place the following:

'Any unencumbered balances remaining at the completion of the
projects in section 6 shall lapse to the debt service account
established for the retirement of these bonds.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 6
and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 6. Allocations from General Fund bond issue.'

The amount listed after each project is to be construed as a guide and, within the Judicial Department, any one or more amounts may be exceeded with the approval of the Governor by transfer from one project to another.'

Further amend the Bill in section 8 by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph and inserting in its place the following: "Shall a bond issue be authorized in the amount of \$4,000,000 for court facilities improvements?"'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to amend the bill to a one time bond issue of \$4,000,000.
