HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1936, L. D. 1988, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Periodic Justification of Departments  
and Agencies of State Government under the Maine Sunset  
Law."

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 18 and  
inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 18. 7 MRSA §486, first sentence is amended to read:

The commissioner shall have ~~all~~ analyses of commodities,  
except milk and cream, examined under the inspection laws of  
which he is the executive, made at the Maine Agricultural  
Experiment Station.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to reinstate the statutory  
provision which requires that analyses of commodities under  
the inspection laws be done at the Maine Agricultural Experiment  
Station.
