SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to H.P. 1936, L.D. 1988, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Periodic Justification of Departments and Agencies of State Government under the Maine Sunset Law."

Amend the bill in Part A by striking out all of section 62.

Further amend the bill in Part A by renumbering sections 63 to 80 to be sections 62 to 79.

Further amend the bill in Part B under the caption "AGRICULTURE, DEPARTMENT OF" by striking out all of the following:

"Positions	(-6)
Personal Services	(83,000)
All Other	(17,900)

Eliminates the appropriation for the State Meat Inspection Program."

Further amend the bill in Part B by striking out all of the last line and inserting in its place the following:

'TOTAL PART B - GENERAL FUND (\$320,800)'

Fiscal Note

This amendment restores \$100,900 (6 positions) to maintain the State Meat Inspection Program. The amendment thus reduces the General Fund savings in the bill from \$335,480 to \$234,570.

Statement of Fact

This amendment reinstates the State Meat Inspection Program eliminated in the bill.
