SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to S.P. 799, L.D. 2003, Bill, "AN ACT to Assure Compliance with Existing Laws Affecting Disabled Persons' Access to Certain Buildings Open to the Public."

Amend the Bill in section 4 in subsection 6-A by striking out all of the last 3 paragraphs and inserting in their place the following:

'The State Fire Marshal shall provide whatever assistance is requested by the Board for Barrier Free Design.


The State Fire Marshal may employ, subject to the Personnel Law, special and clerical assistance to carry out this subsection.

The State Fire Marshal shall not adopt any rule to implement this subsection.'
