STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY

AN ACT to Revise Allocations from the Highway Fund for the Fiscal Years from July 1, 1979 to June 30, 1981, and to Provide Increased Revenues to the Highway Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 23 MRSA \S 1103, as last amended by PL 1979, c. 127, $\S\S$ 151 & 152, is further amended by adding a new paragraph at the end to read:

Notwithstanding this section, for the fiscal year 1980-81 only, the department shall increase its apportionment of state aid by 35% of the state aid joint fund so expended for reconstruction of improved state or state aid highways or for construction of unimproved bridges and approaches under the Bridge Act, provided the bridge is located between sections of improved state aid highways.

Amounting to \$95,008,943 \$86,314,543 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1980, and \$95,786,207 \$89,287,607 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1981.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to revise the allocations from and increase revenues to the highway Fund to compensate for the expected shortfall of \$16,700,000 in revenues to this fund for the biennium of July 1, 1979 to June 30, 1981.

I. Revenue increases

This bill increases operator's license fees by \$1.50 per year, driver examination fees by \$5.00 for initial examinations and \$3 for subsequent examinations, motorcycle license fees by \$5, and certificate of title fees by \$2.
