Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of the first
 line after the enacting clause the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end, before the
 statement of fact, the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropri-
 ated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
