STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Appropriate \$10,000 to the Firemens Training Program in the Department of Educational and Cultural Services.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purpose of this Act.

The amount appropriated is to be used to provide seminars, updated training materials and traveling expenses in connection with the firemens training program.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill appropriates \$10,000 to the firemens training program for seminars, updated materials and travel expenses. The program provides valuable training to municipal fire departments, incorporated volunteer fire departments, industrial and institutional fire brigades.
