COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 28, L.D. 32, Bill, "AN ACT Pertaining to Employment of Minors in Hotels and Motels."

Amend the Bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. 26 MRSA §771, as last amended by PL 1979, c. 468, §2, is further amended by adding after the first sentence a new sentence to read:

No child under 16 years of age may be employed as a chambermaid.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec 3. 26 MRSA §773, first sentence, is amended to read: may No minor under 16 years of age shall/be employed, permitted or suffered to work in, about or in connection with any manufacturing or mechanical establishment, hotel7-rooming-house7 laundry, except those commonly known as automatic laundries, dry cleaning establishments, bakery, bowling alley, poolroom, commercial places of amusement, including traveling shows and circuses, er in any theater or moving picture house, or as a chambermaid in any hotel, motel, rooming house or guest cabin.'

Further amend the Bill by renumbering sections 2 to 4 to be sections 3 to 5.

Statement of Fact

This amendment excepts the job of chambermaid from the bill's provisions allowing employment of minors in hotels and motels.
