SENATE AMENDMENT " C " to H.P. 28, L.D. 32, Bill, "AN  
ACT Pertaining to Employment of Minors in Hotels and Motels."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the  
Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 5. 26 MRSA §775, first ¶ is amended to read:

No minor under 16 years of age shall be employed,  
permitted or suffered to work in, about or in connection  
with any gainful occupation, subject to the prohibitions  
set forth in section 773, unless the person, firm or  
corporation employing such child procures and keeps on file  
accessible to any attendance officer, factory inspector or  
other authorized officer charged with the enforcement of this  
subchapter a work permit issued to such child, with a parent's written  
consent, by the superintendent of schools of the city or  
town in which the child resides, or by some person authorized  
by him in writing.

Sec. 6. 26 MRSA §781 is amended to read:

§781. Penalties; employers

Any person, firm or corporation, agent or manager of  
any firm or corporation, who, either for himself or for some  
firm or corporation, or by himself, or through his agents,  
servants or foremen, employ's, permits or suffers any child  
to be employed, or to work in violation of any of the provisions

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of sections 771 to 780, or otherwise fails to comply with any of the provisions of said sections, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$25 \$100 nor more than \$200 \$500.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require parental consent for minors obtaining work permits and to increase the penalty provisions relating to minors.
