COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 32, L.D. 37, Bill, "AN
ACT to Modify Certain Rules of the Road to Conform with the
Uniform Vehicle Code."

Amend the bill in section 1, ^{in that part designated "§944-A"} /first paragraph, 2nd line
(same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined word "pedestrian"
and inserting in its place the underlined word 'person'

Further amend the bill in section 2, in that part designated
"§946-A." in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (same in L.D.) by
inserting after the underlined words "responding to" the under-
lined words 'but not upon returning from'

Statement of Fact

This amendment gives the right-of-way to any person engaged
in highway work whether or not he is on foot, for example operating
or assisting in the operation of equipment.

This amendment also limits the privileges of this section to
emergency vehicles only when they are responding to an emergency,
but not when they are returning from the emergency call.
