**AN ACT to Encourage the University of Maine Law School to Offer Extension and Evening Programs for Part-time Students.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

20 MRSA § 2257 is enacted to read:

**§ 2257. Legal education and extension programs**

**It is the intent of the Legislature that the University of Maine Law School offer extension and evening programs for part-time students leading to a law degree and that the cost of any such courses or programs be included in the law school budget and be subsidized at the same rate as full-time students.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill states the legislative intent that the University of Maine Law School establish extension and evening courses for part-time students, and that those courses be supported in the same manner as regular courses.
