COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 43, L.D. 49, Bill, "AN ACT to Dissolve the Howland Water and Sewer District"

Amend the Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Town of Howland is starting the construction of a sewerage treatment facility; and

Whereas, funding problems for that facility could arise this spring unless the ~~D~~istrict is dissolved; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 4. Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add an emergency clause to the bill.
