STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Dissolve the Howland Water and Sewer District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P&SL 1921, c. 133, is repealed.

Sec. 2. P&SL 1927, c. 115, is repealed.

Sec. 3. P&SL 1975, c. 75, as amended by PL 1975, c. 623, § 72, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals several private and special laws which attempted to create a water and sewer district for the Town of Howland. The voters of the town have indicated several times that they do not wish to have such a district created. Although trustees were appointed during the 1920's, no action has ever been taken.
