COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 45, L.D. 51, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Provide for the Use of Flashing White Lights on  
Ambulances."

Amend the Bill by striking/<sup>out</sup>everything after the enacting  
clause and inserting in its place the following:

'29 MRSA §1368, sub-§1, first sentence, as repealed and  
replaced by PL 1975, c. 653, is amended to read:  
Lights used on ambulances, fire department vehicles, vehicles  
operated by city and town fire inspectors, forestry department  
vehicles used for forest fire control purposes and by vehicles  
operated by chiefs and chief officers, such as assistant chiefs,  
deputy chiefs and district chiefs of fire departments shall emit  
a red beam of light or a combination of red and white lights.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment will permit new or existing ambulances and  
other emergency vehicles to use a red beam of light or a combination  
of red and white lights. It will conform Maine law to federal  
requirements while permitting existing equipment to continue to  
use present lighting systems.
