HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 52,
L.D. 61, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for a Special Hunting Season
on Bear During the 2nd Week in November."

Amend the amendment by inserting at the end, before the
emergency clause, the following:

'E. Notwithstanding this subsection, there shall be a
closed season on the hunting of bear cubs and female
bear before September 1st for the 1981 calendar year.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to prohibit the hunting of
bear cubs or female bear prior to September 1, 1981. This will
prevent the taking of the cub or the mother bear before the cub
has reached a sufficient size to survive on its own. A violation
of the closed season on bear cubs and female bear would be a Class E
crime under the provisions of Title 12, section 7901.
