STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Provide Free Access for Disabled Veterans to State Parks, Camping Areas and Beaches.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA c. 212 is enacted to read:

CHAPTER 212

FREE ACCESS TO CERTAIN STATE LANDS BY

DISABLED VETERANS

§ 931. Access to state owned parks, camping areas and beaches

Any disabled veteran displaying on his motor vehicle special designating plates or placards issued in accordance with Title 29, section 252-A shall not be assessed a fee for admission to any state-owned park, camping area or beach.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to give disabled veterans free access to state parks, camping areas and beaches.
