STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Require that Barber Shops Post Their Prices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

32 MRSA § 306 is enacted to read:

§ 306. Posting of price list

Each licensed barber shop shall maintain in a conspicuous place a list of the services provided by that shop and the price of each service. The letters and numbers contained in that list shall be no smaller than one inch in height.

Nothing contained in this section may be construed as preventing a barber shop from changing the current price for any service at any time, provided that the listed price is simultaneously adjusted to reflect the new current price.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require barber shops to conspicuously post their prices for the information of their patrons.
