STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Require the State to Pay its Share of School Funding on the First Day of Each Month.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

20 MRSA § 3455, first sentence, as repealed and replaced by PL 1967, c. 544, § 49, is amended to read:

All apportionments to administrative units, academies and institutes under this Title, unless specifically directed by statute, shall be made annually commencing in July of each year in the following manner: An amount not to exceed 1/12 of the subsidy shall be paid each month no later than the last first day of the month.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires the state share of school funding to be paid on the first rather than the last day of each month.
