STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Repeal the Statute Dealing with Failure to File Campaign Finance Reports on Time.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

21 MRSA § 1398, as amended by PL 1979, c. 479, §§ 4 and 5, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to repeal the statute which provides a penalty for failure to file campaign finance reports on time. The provision is not enforced and thus it should be repealed.
