STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Provide that the First Week of Deer Hunting Season in the Northern Zone shall be for Resident Hunters Only.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 7457, sub-§ 1, ¶ E, sub-¶ (3), as enacted by PL 1979, c. 543, § 44, is amended to read:

(3) The Saturday preceding the first day of open season on deer shall be an open day for residents of this State only; **and notwithstanding paragraph A, if the commissioner establishes a northern hunting zone, the first 6 days of the open season in that zone shall be open days for residents of this State only.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that the first week of deer hunting season in the northern zone shall be for residents of the State only.
