STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Exempt Skidders from the Registration Requirement of the Motor Vehicle Laws for Limited Travel.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 255 is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

No registration is required of a log skidder used solely for logging purposes when operated from or to the premises where kept, to or from a wood lot and between wood lots used for logging purposes by the owner of the log skidder. Such a log skidder may be operated without registration to a filling station or garage for gas, oil or repairs.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides, for log skidders, the same exemption from motor vehicle registration requirements as is available to farm tractors and farm trailers.
