IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT Concerning Eye Enucleation under the Anatomical Gift Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

22 MRSA § 2904, sub-§ 4, first sentence, as enacted by PL 1969, c. 193, is amended to read:

Notwithstanding section 2907, subsection 2, the donor may designate in his will, card or other document of gift the surgeon or physician to carry out the appropriate procedures; **provided, however, that eye enucleations may be performed also by a technician who has successfully completed a course of training approved by the commissioner.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit eye enucleations to be done by technicians who have completed a course of training approved by the Commissioner of Human Services.
