HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 63, L.D. 97, Bill,
"AN ACT to Increase the Eating, Lodging and Recreational Place
Licensing Fee."

Amend the Bill in section 1 in the last line (same in L.D.)
by striking out the underlined figure "\$50" and inserting in its
place the underlined figure '\$35'

Statement of Fact

This amendment allows the maximum amount charged for a
license to be \$35, instead of the current \$30 in the law, or the
proposed \$50 in the bill.

This smaller increase should permit the department to
continue their program of inspections, with 6 sanitarians
instead of the 7 now employed. This is a \$5 increase in income
across the board.
