STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Permit School Bus Drivers to be Eligible for Unemployment Compensation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 26 MRSA § 1192, sub-§ 7, ¶ A, as last amended by PL 1977, c. 585, § 2, is further amended by adding at the end the following new sentences to read:

This paragraph does not only apply to school bus drivers. They are eligible to receive benefits during the periods specified in this paragraph.

Sec. 2. 26 MRSA § 1192, sub-§ 7, ¶ C, as last amended by PL 1977, c. 585, § 2, is further amended by adding at the end the following new sentences to read:

This paragraph does not apply to school bus drivers. They are eligible to receive benefits during the periods specified in this paragraph.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows school bus drivers to receive unemployment compensation between academic years.
