STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT Concerning Appointments to the Maine Veterans Home Board of Trustees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

37-A MRSA § 1402, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 562, § 1, is amended by adding after the 4th sentence, the following new sentence to read:

Each of the trustees representing a leading veteran's organization shall be appointed from a list of 3 candidates submitted by the organization which that trustee is to represent.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to ensure that the trustees of the Maine Veterans Home who represent the leading veterans' organizations truly represent the interest of the organizations. The bill would provide that each of the 5 trustees would be appointed from a list of 3 candidates submitted by the organization that the trustees wish to represent.
