COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 99, L.D. 129, Bill,
"AN ACT to Remove Restrictions Preventing the Spouse of a
Teacher from Serving on a School Board."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and
inserting in its place the following: 'AN ACT to Prohibit
the Employment of a Superintendent in the Same School
Administrative Unit which Employs his Spouse.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after
the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'20 MRSA §152, as amended by PL 1975, c. 746, §2, is
further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

A person may not be employed as a superintendent in a
school administrative unit which employs his spouse. A
superintendent employed by a unit prior to July 1, 1981, which
employed his spouse prior to July 1, 1981, is exempt from this
provision.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment removes the potential of a conflict
of interest in school systems which employ the spouse of a
superintendent.
