COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 100, L.D. 130, Bill, "AN ACT to Require School Districts to Account for Federally Subsidized Pupils as Residents of the District."

Amend the bill in the first line after the amending clause by striking out the following: "may shall elect to consider" and inserting  
/in its place the following: '~~may elect to consider~~ shall count'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the bill by making it clear that the district "shall count pupils as residents of the district."
