COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 103, L.D. 137, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Raising of Wild Waterfowl in Captivity."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'12 MRSA §7235, sub-§5, ¶D is enacted to read:

D. Notwithstanding subsection 4, metallic seals are not required for wild waterfowl marked in accordance with applicable federal regulations.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment exempts all wild waterfowl, including mallard ducks, from the requirement for marking with metal seals if the birds are marked in accordance with federal requirements.
