**AN ACT to Set the Length Limit on Salmon in East Grand Lake at 16 Inches.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 7556-A is enacted to read:

§ 7556-A. **Salmon; East Grand Lake**

**The minimum length for salmon on East Grand Lake is 16 inches.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill sets the length limit on salmon in East Grand Lake at 16 inches.
