STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Establish a Sign on the Maine Turnpike for York Beach Region.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

23 MRSA § 1201, sub-§ 32 is enacted to read:

32. York Region. Such sign shall be constructed and maintained on the Maine Turnpike no more than 2 miles northerly from exit 1 and shall be worded as follows:

York Region Recreational Area

York Beach — York

York Harbor — Cape Neddick

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides for a sign on the Maine Turnpike to indicate the York-York Beach region exit.
