STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE

AN ACT to Provide Free Pheasant Hunting Stamps to Disabled Veterans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 7076, sub-§ 4, first sentence, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, § 1, is amended to read:

A complimentary license to hunt or fish, or a combination hunting and fishing license **and, if requested, a pheasant hunting permit**, shall be issued to any resident of Maine who:

The purpose of this bill is to provide complimentary pheasant hunting permits to disabled veterans.
