HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 143,
L.D. 169, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Use of Force to Protect
Property."

Amend the Amendment in that part designated "§105."
in subsection 2, paragraph A by striking out all of sub-
paragraphs (1) and (2) and inserting in their place the
following:

'(1) To prevent the other's imminent commission
of burglary, robbery, Class B or/C theft by
unauthorized taking in the nighttime or aggravated
criminal mischief in the nighttime.'

Further amend the Amendment in that part designated "§105."
in subsection 2 by striking out all of paragraph B.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to limit the use of
deadly force to commission of burglary, robbery, Class B or C
theft in the nighttime or aggravated criminal mischief in the
nighttime.
