COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 145, L.D. 171, Bill,
"AN ACT to Amend the Disorderly Conduct Statute to Include
Instances of Affray."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting
clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1.
/17-A MRSA §501, sub-§1, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 499,
§1, is amended to read:

A. Making loud and unreasonable noises; ~~or~~

Sec. 2. 17-A MRSA §501, sub-§1, ¶C is enacted to read:

C. Engaging in fighting, after having been ordered by a
law enforcement officer to cease fighting;

Statement of Fact

This amendment amends the bill to make actually engaging
in fighting, after having been ordered by a law enforcement
officer to cease, a form of disorderly conduct.
