HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 146, L.D. 172, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize Municipal Ordinances Preventing Drinking in Public."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'30 MRSA §2151, sub-§2, ¶K is enacted to read:'

Further amend the Bill in the first line after the amending clause by striking out the underlined letter and punctuation "J." and inserting in its place the underlined letter and punctuation 'K.'

This amendment is offered on behalf of the Committee on Bills in Second Reading to remove an allocation conflict between this bill and Public Law 1981, chapter 308.
